

RESOLUTION #08-01-14

WHEREAS, the Town of Salem has used one polling place—Polling Place #1 in the Community Board Room of Town Hall for a number of years and this polling place has served the Town well; and

WHEREAS, the number of voters in the Town has grown making it more difficult to conduct elections at only the one polling place; and

WHEREAS, it would be advantageous to use a second polling place to relieve overcrowding at the one existing polling place; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Salem has determined that the use of Wilmot Fire Station as a second polling place serves the needs of the electorate based on the station’s proximity to Wards 4, 8, 9, and 10.

WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin Elections Board has confirmed that locating the second polling place at Wilmot Fire Station serves the needs of the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby designates the Wilmot Fire Station as Polling Place #2 for all future elections, unless specifically voted otherwise by the Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Polling Place #1 (Salem Town Hall) be used for Wards 1, 2, 3, 5, 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15; that Polling Place #2 be used for Wards 4, 8, 9, and 10.

This Resolution was duly adopted by motion at a meeting held January 14, 2008
