

**VILLAGE OF SALEM LAKES  
VOTING BY ABSENTEE BALLOT  
FEBRUARY 21, 2016 PRIMARY ELECTION**

Any qualified elector who is unable or unwilling to appear at the polling place on Election Day may request to vote an absentee ballot. A qualified elector is any U.S. citizen, who will be 18 years of age or older on Election Day, who has resided in the ward or municipality where he or she wishes to vote for at least 10 consecutive days before the election. The elector must also be registered to vote in order to receive an absentee ballot. Proof of identification must be provided before an absentee ballot may be issued.

**TO OBTAIN AN ABSENTEE BALLOT YOU MUST MAKE A REQUEST IN WRITING.**

Contact your municipal clerk (listed below) and request that an application for an absentee ballot be sent to you for the February 21, 2017 Primary Election. You may also request an absentee ballot by letter. Your written request must list your voting address within the municipality where you wish to vote, the address where the absentee ballot should be sent, if different, and your signature. You must also provide Proof of Identification with your request.

**MAKING APPLICATION TO RECEIVE AN ABSENTEE BALLOT BY MAIL**

The deadline for making application to receive an absentee ballot by mail is:

5:00 pm on the fifth day before the election. (Thursday, February 16, 2017)

Note: Special absentee voting application provisions apply to electors who are indefinitely confined to home or a care facility, in the military, hospitalized, or serving as a sequestered juror. If this applies to you, contact the municipal clerk regarding deadlines for requesting and submitting an absentee ballot.

You can also request and vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office during the days and hours specified below for casting an absentee ballot in person.

The first day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is Monday, January 30, 2017.  
The last day to vote an absentee ballot in the clerk's office is 5:00 p.m. on Friday,  
February 17, 2017.

**No in-person absentee voting may occur on the day before the election.**

The municipal clerk will deliver voted ballots returned on or before Election Day to the proper polling place or counting location before the polls close on **Tuesday, February 21, 2017.** Any absentee ballots received after the polls close will be not be counted.
