The Emergency Services Network is a collaboration of community based agencies dedicated to helping the less fortunate citizens of Kenosha County.

## OUR FUNDING

Emergency Services Network agencies are primarily funded by State, Federal and County dollars, as well as special grants, and the generous support of the residents in our community.

## OTHER ESN EVENTS

**Holiday House** is a consortium of ESN agencies that coordinate seasonal and holiday events, providing assistance to Kenosha area children and their families who are in need through the following events:

### **Winter Wraps:**

Distributes needed coats, hats, mittens/gloves and scarves to families of Kenosha. This event takes place in late October.

### **Thanksgiving Food Distribution:**

Food distribution for Thanksgiving takes place later in November. This event allows distribution of a Thanksgiving meal to the needy families of Kenosha.

### **Christmas Toy and Food Distribution:**

This event distributes toys and a Christmas meal basket to Kenosha families in need. Qualified children receive one toy from this event.

**Salvation Army** offers a Christmas food and toy distribution to Kenosha area families.

**Sharing Center** offers Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas food distributions to Western Kenosha County families.
