NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT on THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2010, in advance of this meeting, a Public Hearing on the proposed Fiscal Year 2011 Budget will begin at 7:00 PM, at the Salem Town Hall. At the close of that Public Hearing, this Special Town Meeting of the Electors will be called pursuant to Section 60.12 of Wisconsin State Statutes by the Town Board for the following purposes.

This is not a TOWN BOARD Meeting. Town Board members are equal electors at this meeting.

- 1.) Call to Order
- 2.) Pledge of Allegiance
- 3.) Roll Call of Town Board
- 4.) Open Meeting Compliance Check
- 5.) ELECTORS COMMENTS - *Please be advised per Wisconsin Act 123, the Electors will receive information from the other electors of the town for a three minute time period, with time extensions per discretion of the Chairperson of the meeting, per person. Be further advised that after the elector comments are completed, the Town Board Supervisors may have limited discussion on the information received but no Town Board action can or will be taken.*
- 6.) Motion to have written into the Town Administrator's contract that residency to the State of Wisconsin, preferably the Town of Salem be required so that he will have a vested interest for the town that he is setting the budget for.
- 7.) Motion to explore incorporation (gather information) so that we can avoid losing parts of our borders to adjoining town and or villages. (ie Paddock Lake and Silver Lake).
- 8.) Motion directing the Town Board of Salem be prohibited from transferring funds from the Town of Salem Storm Water Utility District and the Town of Salem Sanitary Sewer Utility District for any other fund or funds used other than what they were collected for including the completion of necessary legal documents to document this electors decision.

9.) Motion that the Parks Commission be disabled and a Parks Department be created in order to better serve the community.

10.) Consideration and possible action on the approval of the total 2011 Highway Expenditures pursuant to Section 82.03 of Wisconsin Statutes.

11.) Consideration and possible action on the approval of the 2010 Town of Salem tax levy, to be paid in 2011, pursuant to Section 60.10(1)(a) of Wisconsin Statutes.

12.) Adjournment
