

**PARK COMMISSION**  
**04/22/2010**

The Town of Salem Park Commission held its monthly meeting at the Salem Town Hall, 9814 Antioch Rd., Salem, WI 53168 on Thursday, April 22, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. Park Commission members present were: Jo Weidman-Chairman, Diann Tesar, Karen Ihlen, Larry Kamin, Bill Barhyte and Mark Eberle. Crysti Neuman was excused. Others present were: Pat Casey, Administrator; Mike Murdock, Hwy Dept.; and Marilyn Glaze, Park Commission Secretary.

1. Chairman Weidman called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
2. Larry Kamin motioned to approve minutes from 3/17/10. Bill Barhyte seconded. Motion approved 6-0.
3. Bill Barhyte motioned to approve the Treasurer's Report, Larry Kamin seconded. Motion approved 6-0.
4. Citizen Comments: None.
5. Diann Tesar motioned to allow a shrub (no tree) to be planted in Camp Lake Park to block the view of the porta potty as long as it is put in the proper place and they pay for it. Motion approved 4-2.
6. Larry Kamin motioned to recommend to the Town Board to re-appoint current members of the Park Commission Karen Ihlen and Mark Eberle and keep other application on file; Bill Barhyte seconded. Motion approved 4-0 (Karen Ihlen and Mark Eberle abstained).
7. Old Business - The Grand Opening for Salem Community Park is officially set for Saturday, May 15, at 9 a.m. Mark Eberle motioned to spend up to \$200 out of the Park Budget for refreshments. Motion approved 6-0. Invitations will be sent out to local officials.
8. New Business –
  - Karen Ihlen is looking into getting a refrigerator donated for the park pavilion.
  - Grants have been applied for to connect sections of the park.
  - The Eagle Scout project for Nick Manning has been reapproved.
  - The Town is looking into hiring summer help to do lawn maintenance at the Community Park.
  - There is an area on 264<sup>th</sup> Ave. south of Hwy SA near Trevor Grade School that could be developed into a park.
  - Salem Oaks Park needs some upgrading - more equipment and address the drainage problem.
  - There is money in the Park fund to develop more parks or buy property.
  - Shaw's property off of 84<sup>th</sup> St. is 20 acres of prime land. The Park Commission needs to look into the cost of putting in an access road on the property.
  - Mike Murdock has 6 sugar maple saplings that need to be planted.
  - The Park Commission needs to make a Spring run to check on all the town parks.
10. Larry Kamin motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mark Eberle. Unanimously approved. Meeting adjourned at 7:55 p.m.
