



TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton



In January of 2015 we were dispatched to **95** calls. EMS was dispatched to **84** calls, **10** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **85** calls, **11** calls without an EMS response. There were **78** patient contacts made.

Of the 78 patient contacts:

- 28 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 22 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 3 were transported to Burlington Memorial
- 8 signed off AMA
- 11 signed off DOI
- 2 were DOA
- 3 were a intercepts
- 1 was transported to Condell from a mutual aid call

We were dispatched to:

- 44 – ALS Calls
- 15 – ILS Calls
- 10 – BLS Calls
- 4 – 10-50's
- 4 – Structure Fires
- 3 – Single Engine Responses
- 4 – Supervisory Alarms
- 1 – CO Alarms
- 1 – Gas Main Break
- 5 – Patient Assists
- 2 – Burning Violations
- 1- Water Call
- 1 – Standby / Change of Quarters

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 66 – Town of Salem
- 17 – Paddock Lake
- 5 – Brighton
- 7 – Mutual Aid

Stations Responded as follows:

- 10 – EMS Response Only
- 31 – Station 1
- 48 – Station 2
- 6 – Station 3

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 3 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 5 – Second Calls
- 1 – Third or more call

Patients were treated and transported:

- 48 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care
