



TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton



In February of 2015 we were dispatched to **83** calls. EMS was dispatched to **72** calls, **12** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **71** calls, **11** calls without an EMS response. There were **68** patient contacts made.

Of the 68 patient contacts:

- 25 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 20 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 3 were transported to Burlington Memorial
- 4 signed off AMA
- 10 signed off DOI
- 2 were DOA
- 1 was an intercept
- 1 was an agency assist only
- 1 was transported to Condell
- 1 was transported to NIMC

We were dispatched to:

- 38 – ALS Calls
- 10 – ILS Calls
- 8 – BLS Calls
- 6 – 10-50's
- 5 – Structure Fires
- 7 – Single Engine Responses
- 3 – Supervisory Alarms
- 1 – CO Alarms
- 1 – Gas Main Break
- 1 – Patient Assists
- 1 – Water Call
- 2 – Standby / Change of Quarters

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 64 – Town of Salem
- 8 – Paddock Lake
- 0 – Brighton
- 11 – Mutual Aid

Stations Responded as follows:

- 12 – EMS Response Only
- 26 – Station 1
- 35 – Station 2
- 10 – Station 3

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 4 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 7 – Second Calls
- 1 – Third or more call

Patients were treated and transported:

- 41 – ALS Care
- 10 – BLS Care
