



TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton



In June of 2015 we were dispatched to **113** calls. EMS was dispatched to **104** calls, **17** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **96** calls, **9** calls without an EMS response. There were **93** patient contacts made.

Of the 93 patient contacts:

- 41 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 20 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 3 were transported to Aurora Burlington
- 11 signed off AMA
- 14 signed off DOI
- 1 was DOA
- 1 was a Paramedic intercept
- 1 was transferred to Flight for Life
- 1 was transferred to another provider

We were dispatched to:

- 40 – ALS Calls
- 23 – ILS Calls
- 15 – BLS Calls
- 8 – 10-50's
- 6 – Structure Fires
- 8 – Single Engine Responses
- 1 – CO Alarms
- 7 – Supervisory Alarms
- 3 – Burning Violations
- 1 – Gas Main Breaks
- 1 – Standby / Change of quarters

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 78 – Town of Salem
- 19 – Paddock Lake
- 5 – Brighton
- 11 – Mutual Aid

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 4 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 7 – Second Calls

Patients were treated and transported:

- 55 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care
