



TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton



In September of 2015 we were dispatched to **91** calls. EMS was dispatched to **86** calls, **12** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **84** calls, **5** calls without an EMS response. There were **86** patient contacts made.

Of the 86 patient contacts:

- 33 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 23 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 5 were transported to Aurora Burlington
- 13 signed off AMA
- 10 signed off DOI
- 1 were DOA
- 1 was transferred to Flight for Life

We were dispatched to:

- 39 – ALS Calls
- 11 – ILS Calls
- 13 – BLS Calls
- 10 – 10-50's
- 6 – Structure Fires
- 3 – Single Engine Responses
- 4 – Supervisory Alarms
- 1 – Burning Violations
- 1 – Gas Main Breaks
- 2 – Patient Assists
- 1 – Water Call

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 63 – Town of Salem
- 16 – Paddock Lake
- 8 – Brighton
- 4 – Mutual Aid

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 7 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 7 – Second Calls

Patients were treated and transported:

- 52 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care

Stations Responded as follows:

- 12 – EMS Response Only
- 29 – Station 1
- 42 – Station 2
- 5 – Station 3
- 2 – Calls were handled by Mutual Aid companies
- 1—Call was a special team only call
