



# TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

*Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton*



In October of 2015 we were dispatched to **99** calls. EMS was dispatched to **89** calls, **16** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **83** calls, **10** calls without an EMS response. There were **88** patient contacts made.

Of the 88 patient contacts:

- 35 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 22 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 5 were transported to Aurora Burlington
- 12 signed off AMA
- 9 signed off DOI
- 1 were DOA
- 1 was transported to Kenosha Memorial Hospital
- 2 were Paramedic intercepts
- 1 was transferred to Flight for Life

We were dispatched to:

- 40 – ALS Calls
- 13 – ILS Calls
- 19 – BLS Calls
- 8 – 10-50's
- 1 – Vehicle Fire
- 5 – Structure Fires
- 3 – Single Engine Responses
- 2 – Carbon Monoxide Alarms
- 2 – Supervisory Alarms
- 3 – Burning Violations
- 2 – Patient Assists
- 1 – Water Call

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 64 – Town of Salem
- 24 – Paddock Lake
- 5 – Brighton
- 6 – Mutual Aid

Stations Responded as follows:

- 16 – EMS Response Only
- 30 – Station 1
- 45 – Station 2
- 7 – Station 3
- 1—Call was a special team only call

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 6 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 9 – Second Calls
- 1 – Third Call

Patients were treated and transported:

- 56 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care
