



TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton



In November of 2015 we were dispatched to **102** calls. EMS was dispatched to **93** calls, **11** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **91** calls, **9** calls without an EMS response. There were **77** patient contacts made.

Of the 77 patient contacts:

- 27 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 27 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 4 were transported to Aurora Burlington
- 8 signed off AMA
- 9 signed off DOI
- 1 were DOA
- 1 was transferred to Flight for Life

We were dispatched to:

- 47 – ALS Calls
- 15 – ILS Calls
- 10 – BLS Calls
- 5 – 10-50's
- 9 – Structure Fires
- 3 – Single Engine Responses
- 1 – Carbon Monoxide Alarm
- 3 – Supervisory Alarms
- 1 – Burning Violation
- 7 – Patient Assists
- 1 – Water Call

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 66 – Town of Salem
- 18 – Paddock Lake
- 5 – Brighton
- 13 – Mutual Aid

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 1 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 9 – Second Calls

Patients were treated and transported:

- 49 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care

Stations Responded as follows:

- 11 – EMS Response Only
- 29 – Station 1
- 50 – Station 2
- 11 – Station 3
- 1—Call was a special team only call
