



# TOWN OF SALEM FIRE / RESCUE

*Proudly Protecting the Town of Salem, Village of Paddock Lake and Town of Brighton*



In December of 2015 we were dispatched to **90** calls. EMS was dispatched to **77** calls, **17** calls without a Fire response. Fire responded to **86** calls, **13** calls without an EMS response. There were **74** patient contacts made.

Of the 77 patient contacts:

- 30 were transported to St. Catherine's Hospital
- 15 were transported to Aurora Kenosha
- 4 were transported to Aurora Burlington
- 5 signed off AMA
- 11 signed off DOI
- 3 were DOA
- 4 were intercepts with Silver Lake Rescue
- 2 were transferred to Flight for Life

We were dispatched to:

- 32 – ALS Calls
- 9 – ILS Calls
- 20 – BLS Calls
- 6 – 10-50's
- 8 – Structure Fires
- 7 – Single Engine Responses
- 2 – Carbon Monoxide Alarm
- 3 – Supervisory Alarms
- 1 – Burning Violation
- 1 – Patient Assists
- 1 – Standby / Change of Quarters

The locations of the calls broke down as follows:

- 58 – Town of Salem
- 15 – Paddock Lake
- 7 – Brighton
- 10 – Mutual Aid

Patients were treated and transported:

- 40 – ALS Care
- 9 – BLS Care

Stations Responded as follows:

- 17 – EMS Response Only
- 24 – Station 1
- 39 – Station 2
- 7 – Station 3
- 1 – Call was a special team only call
- 2 – Calls were handled by Mutual Aid companies

Additional ambulances were needed for:

- 3 – Multiple Patient Calls
- 6 – Second Calls
