## Contact your insurance company regarding your ISO Rating


It May Save You Some Money !

The Town of Salem Fire and Rescue Department is proud to announce that as of June 1<sup>st</sup> 2013 we have been awarded an ISO PPC Rating of Class 6 (Class 10 if you live more than five road miles from any Town of Salem fire station).

The Insurance Service Organization (ISO) evaluates and assesses fire protection in municipalities and applies a Public Protection Classification (PPC) for your local fire department. ISO analyses data on fire protection divided into three areas: the Fire Department (50%), the Water Supply System (40%), and Communications (10%). The numbers generated are like a grading system from Class 1 (most desirable) to Class 10 (least desirable). ISO believes that a community's investment in fire mitigation is a proven and reliable predictor of future fire losses.

Prior to being evaluated last fall the ISO rating for our residents was Class 7 if you lived 5 driving miles from the fire station Hwy 83 and Class 9 if you did not. What does this mean to you? Insurance companies utilize this classification to help establish fair premiums for fire insurance. It is estimated that an average savings of around 25-35% can be expected with the change in rating from Class 9 to Class 6. Please check with your insurance carrier, to discuss our new ISO rating and see what kind of a difference it can make for you.

The Town of Salem Fire and Rescue Department takes great pride in the announcement of this achievement and in exceeding this higher level of expectation in our response area.

## **BE FIRE SAFE THIS GRILLING SEASON**

### **SAFETY TIPS**

- ◆ **Never leave a grill unattended!**
- ◆ Keep children away from the grill!
- ◆ Use proper barbecue tools and hot gloves, and stand back when opening grill.
- ◆ Keep combustibles and flammables away from grills!
- ◆ Keep nearby doors and windows closed when grilling.

### **CHARCOAL GRILLS**

- ◆ Grill on a flat surface away from combustibles.
- ◆ Only use charcoal starter, match light charcoal, or an electric charcoal starter.
- ◆ Never use gasoline to start the grill!
- ◆ Do not add starter fluid when the grill is flaming.
- ◆ When grilling under an overhang, do not use charcoal starter fluid.
- ◆ When done cooking, close lid and all vents, or soak the coal with water.
- ◆ When emptying coals out of the grill, place them in a covered metal container and keep them outside away from all combustibles.

### **LP GAS GRILLS**

- ◆ Stand back when igniting the grill.
- ◆ Make sure all hose connections are tight and cylinder is secured to the grill.
- ◆ Always turn gas off when done grilling.
- ◆ Keep LP tank painted and rust free.
- ◆ Never ignite your grill with the lid closed.
- ◆ Clean off excess grease and empty grease can regularly.

### **STAY COOL WHEN THINGS FLARE UP!!!**

In case you have a fire due to grilling follow these steps:

1. Remain calm.
2. Put the lid on the grill, and turn off the gas if possible when using a gas grill.
3. Use an extinguisher if appropriate.
4. Don't delay to call 911 to get the fire department responding.
5. Sound the alarm to family and friends near the grill. Get away, meet at a safe distance outside for the fire department.

*Follow these tips and guidelines and the only thing that will end up well done is your steak, not you or your building!*
