

**Special Notice To Salem Electors  
Regarding  
Spring Elections in the Village of Salem Lakes**

NOTICE HEREBY GIVEN that the Cooperative Agreement adopted by the Town of Salem and the Village of Silver Lake has been approved by the Wisconsin Department of Administration. The Cooperative Agreement results in the merger of the Town of Salem into the Village of Silver Lake prior to the 2017 Spring Elections under the new name of the Village of Salem Lakes.

**Electors currently residing in the Town of Salem and the Village of Silver Lake will be electors in the Village of Salem Lakes and, as such, are eligible to vote for, and stand as candidates for, elective offices in the Village of Salem Lakes.**

At the Spring Election to be held on April 4, 2017, and primary, if required, to be held on February 21, 2017, the following offices in the Village of Salem Lakes (formerly known as the Village of Silver Lake), held by the designated incumbents, will be contested:

Village Trustee Doug Randolph  
Municipal Judge Marlene Engstrom

All persons, including any current Town of Salem elector becoming an elector in the Village of Salem Lakes by virtue of the approved boundary agreement, seeking election to one of the designated offices will be required to file nomination papers with the clerk of the Village of Silver Lake. The first day to circulate nomination papers is December 1, 2016 and the final day for filing nomination papers in the Office of the Silver Lake Village Clerk is 5:00 P.M. on Tuesday, January 3, 2017.
